Any registrations after April 5th be on-site at the Marriott Marquis Hotel. If registration does not fill, there will be space for all on-site registrations in the meeting rooms.


TDS must receive notice of cancellation for refund emailed or postmarked no later than **April 12th**.

RESIDENT HOUSING STIPEND

The TDS offers a generous housing stipend to all Texas residents that are current TDS members who attend the meeting. Each resident that applies for the stipend will be presented with a housing stipend reimbursement form at the resident lunch that will take place on Friday, April 19th at 11AM.

This form should be filled out and returned to the TDS registration table or business office within a week of the meeting. Each resident will have one night reimbursed in host hotel at the discounted TDS room rate or at another hotel for the same rate or lower. If the room booked is over the discounted TDS room rate, the room will be reimbursed at the room rate and the difference will be paid by the resident.



Only current Texas residents who are TDS members can apply for and receive the stipend.



Residents who reside in the host city are NOT eligible for the stipend.



The TDS will only reimburse for one night TDS discounted hotel rate, applicable taxes, resort fee (if applicable) and one night of self-parking.



If valet parking/food/extra charges are submitted for reimbursement, the TDS will deduct the appropriate amount and reimburse only for eligible expenses
